MENU Bio's

BORAH BURGER:

WILLIAM EDGAR BORAH

(June 29, 1865 - January 19, 1940) was a Republican United States Senator, one of the best-known figures in Idaho's history. A progressive who served from 1907 until his death in 1940, Borah is often considered an isolationist, for he led the Irreconcilables, senators who would not accept the Treaty of Versailles, Senate ratification of which would have made the U.S. part of the League of Nations.

C. BEN ROSS CAESAR:

CHARLES BENJAMIN ROSS

(December 27, 1876 - March 31, 1946) was the first Idaho-born Governor of Idaho and an important Idaho political figure throughout the 1930s. Ross served as governor from 1931 until 1937.

HARRIMAN HARVEST SALAD:

W. AVERELL HARRIMAN

(November 15, 1891 - July 26, 1986) served as the 48th Governor of New York and was Secretary of Commerce under President Harry S. Truman. He later owned Union Pacific Railroad and along with Count Felix Schaffgotsch found Sun Valley Resort in Sun Valley, Idaho.

HAWLEY HAM & EGG:

JAMES HENRY HAWLEY

(January 17, 1847 - August 3, 1929) was an American attorney and politician from Idaho. He was state's ninth Governor from 1911 to 1913, and the mayor of Boise from 1903 to 1905.

MCCONNELL MONTE CRISTO:

WILLIAM JOHN MCCONNELL

(September 18, 1839 - March 30, 1925) was the third Governor of Idaho from 1893 until 1897. He had previously represented the new state as one of its first United States Senators; Idaho achieved statehood in July 1890.

PINNEY POTATO CROQUETTES:

JAMES ALONZO PINNEY

(September 29, 1835 - February 4, 1914) served as mayor of Boise, Idaho Territory (later Boise, Idaho) in the late 19th century and early 20th century. He is the only person in the city's history to serve as mayor three nonconsecutive times and win election as mayor five times. Pinney was Boise mayor when Idaho Territory became the U.S. state of Idaho in July 1890.

STEUNENBERG SALMON:

FRANK STEUNENBERG

(August 8, 1861 - December 30, 1905) was the fourth Governor of the State of Idaho, serving from 1897 until 1901. In 1905 he was assassinated in Caldwell, Idaho.
